## Principal Report

### Bus Duty (3pm-3:30pm)

You may have noticed that I have asked all students to wait with the teacher on bus duty from 3pm -3:30pm. I had concerns regarding our schools expectations not being followed and the safety for all students during this time. I was also concerned about the students waiting at the bus shelter unsupervised and acting inappropriately. Student safety is of the highest importance at Kalbar State School.

#### Bus Duty Expectations:

- All students walk to the shed and sit in their bus line
- Students waiting for mums, dads and/or high school siblings wait quietly in the shed
- Teacher on duty arrives and marks the bus roll
- Teacher releases students to play
- Prep-Yr3 play on the fort
- Yr4-Yr6 play on grassed areas around the shed
- Handball can be played on the concrete
- Students leaving with mum, dad or sibling acknowledge teacher on duty of their departure
- Students line up in bus lines and walk with the teacher to the bus shelter
