This Week's Reading Tip

Reading helps children learn about **their world**. Children's books, especially picture books, often reinforce the familiar events of a child's world: going to bed, going to school, habits of hygiene and nutrition, etc. Seeing characters in a book take baths, brush teeth, and say goodnight to toys gives a context for their own daily routine. Other books can teach about things your child has not yet encountered, such as going to a new school, visit-

ing a zoo or a museum, or traveling on public transport.

Below is a tip from Professor Matt Sanders, the founder of 'Triple P' – Positive Parenting Program.

Dealing with Disappointment By Professor Matt Sanders

Despite what certain sport shoe commercials might have you believe, life isn't always about winning.

It is equally important for the development of healthy self-esteem that children learn how to deal with disappointment.

As a reaction to not getting what they want, such as being chosen for a team, children may sometimes put themselves down, saying things like: "I'm dumb", "you hate me" or "I'm just stupid". If this happens, try to avoid being too sympathetic. Instead encourage your child to try again after the set-back and to enjoy the activity or game even if they aren't the winner.

Rather than simply reassuring your child that everything will be okay,

you can help your child develop their own sense of worth by letting them know that you understand their feelings of disappointment and that you are there to help them work out a reasonable way of dealing with that disappointment.

Remember too, when you're helping your child with an activity or with homework concentrate on effort not results. Praising your child for trying and making an improvement will motivate them to continue trying at a difficult task.

INTENT TO ATTEND FORM

We are now offering students from Kalbar State School an examination and treatment at the school dental van currently at your school. Parent / legal guardian are required to attend dental appointments.

Child eligibility Criteria:

For children to be eligible for free public oral health service they must:

Be Queensland residents or attend a Queensland School; and,
Be eligible for Medicare; and

Meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Be aged 4 years or older and have not completed year 10; or,
- Be eligible for the Medicare Child Dental Benefits Schedule; or,
- Hold, or be listed as a dependent on, a valid Centrelink concession card.

Please note

- It is a requirement that parents/legal guardians attend appointments for their children at the Dental Van to complete the necessary forms and to discuss any concerns they may have about their children's oral health.
- Appointments will be offered in family groups to all students.
- Before and after school appointments are limited.
- Failure to attend an appointment will result in your child's treatment being delayed until contact is received from a parent/guardian

CDBS eligible clients:

It is a requirement for QLD Oral Health to bulk bill all CDBS eligible clients. Opting to use your CDBS funds within our service will ensure NO FEES OR OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES even if your benefit cap has been reached. If you choose not to use the CDBS funds with our service you have the option of attending a private dentist.
