Child and Adolescent Oral Health Service**

How to register for an appointment:

You will be contacted with an appointment (please allow some time)

Or

- Phone the Business Service Centre **1300 763 246 Monday – Thursday 8:00am – 3:00pm** (*please have your Medicare Card on hand*). Details will be taken and you will be contacted with an appointment.

The School Dental Service has been looking after the oral health needs of Queensland's children since 1975. Your child will receive treatment from experienced paediatric oral health staff including dentists, dental/oral health therapists and dental assistants.

Your child is eligible if they are:

A Queensland resident or attend a Queensland School **and** are eligible for Medicare **and** meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 4 years old up to year 10
- Are named on current concession card (Pension/Health Care)
- 2 – 17 years of age and are eligible for the Child Dental Benefit Schedule

Please note:

To ensure you are fully informed of your child's treatment, **a parent/legal guardian must attend** the first appointment to discuss your child's **dental/medical history** and to provide **consent** for treatment.

CDBS eligible clients:

Qld Health bulk bills all CDBS eligible clients. If your CDBS limit is reached we will continue treating your child with no out of pocket expenses.

If you choose not to use the CDBS funds with our service you have the option of attending a private dentist.

Things to remember:

- Your contact details change or
- Your child requires urgent dental care.
