Dental Van Appointment Notice



West Moreton Health,

How to register for an appointment:

You will be contacted with an appointment (please allow some time)

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Phone the Business Service Centre 1300 763 246 Monday – Thursday 8:00am – 3:00pm (please have your Medicare Card on hand). Details will be taken and you will be contacted with an appointment.

The <u>School Dental Service</u> has been looking after the oral health needs of Queensland's children since 1975. Your child will receive treatment from experienced paediatric oral health staff including dentists, dental/oral health therapists and dental assistants.

Your child is eligible if they are:

A Queensland resident or attend a Queensland School **and** are eligible for Medicare **and** meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 4 years old up to year 10
- · Are named on current concession card (Pension/Health Care)
- 2 17 years of age and are eligible for the Child Dental Benefit Schedule

Please note:

To ensure you are fully informed of your child's treatment, a parent/legal guardian must attend the first appointment to discuss your child's dental/medical history and to provide consent for treatment.

CDBS eligible clients:

Qld Health bulk bills all CDBS eligible clients. If your CDBS limit is reached we will continue treating your child with no out of pocket expenses. If you choose not to use the CDBS funds with our service you have the option of attending a private dentist.








STAFF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DAYS

Staff professional development days for teachers are January 24, 25, April 8, 9, 10 and October 21. Schools are able to decide when they undertake the required hours for professional development for the flexible days, as long as they are on the flexible days, in the school holidays or out of school hours.

PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

Queensland public holidays are set by the Industrial Relations Minister.

Public holidays for a local show are not shown due to diversity of dates across the state.

FINAL DATES FOR STUDENT ATTENDANCE

November 15 is the final date for Year 12 attendance for receipt of a Senior Statement. November 29 is the final date for student attendance in Years 10 and 11.

Some schools in regional, rural and remote areas will close for the summer holidays on December 6.
