2019 Prep Orientation Information

Dear Parents and Carers

You are invited to attend with your Prep Student for 2019, Orientation sessions to familiarise yourself and your child with our school and facilities. If you have any further questions or concerns please contact the school for more information.

Wednesday Pre-Prep Sessions- Every 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month Pre-Preps are invited into our Prep class room from 12-1.10pm. Parents are welcome to drop their child off for this session (parent to stay close by) along with visiting students. This is an ideal opportunity for students to become familiar with their prospective classroom under the guidance of the current Prep Teacher.

Prep Open Day (Sat) – SEPTEMBER 8TH 10am -2pm

Parents and Prep students are welcome to visit the Prep Precinct throughout the day. Staff will be on hand to answer any questions and interact with prospective students and their family.

Prep Open Evening (Wed) – SEPTEMBER 12TH 3.30-7pm

Parents and Prep students are welcome to visit the Prep Precinct throughout this timeframe. Staff will be on hand to answer questions and interact with prospective students and their family.

October 17th (Wed) – Prep Information Session. This will be held in our library (1.45pm- 2.45pm) an overview of the Prep Curriculum will be given as well as information about uniforms and general preparation for Prep. Children are able to attend and will be supervised whilst the Parent Information Session takes place.

October 24th (Wed) – Move On Day. Prep children for 2019 are invited to spend a day at 'school'- this is an opportunity for Teachers to

get to know students and students get to experience a day in their new surroundings. Parents will need to sign a permission form for their child to attend on this day and outline any medical conditions for this transition activity.

The day will run from 9.30am until 2.30pm.

- ✓ Bag with lunch box – enough food for the day- we have a brain food snack at 10 am (usually a sandwich), 1st break food and 2nd break food.
- ✓ Comfortable play clothes- they do not need a school uniform for this day. It must be a sun safe shirt with sleeves, covered in footwear, no thongs please.
