Kalbar State School will strive to achieve:

- 90% of all students in Prep – Year 6 meet school based Reading benchmarks by the end of 2018.
- 100% of Year 3 and Year 5 students above the NMS for writing
- 50% of students in Year 3 and Year 5 achieving Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN
- 100% teaching staff engaged in regular coaching and feedback sessions.
- 100% teaching staff utilising data to influence their teaching
