## This funding will be used to

Increase the proportion of students in the upper two bands in Year 3 and Year 5. Below are the targeted increases expected as a result of Investing for Success funding:

Area	% in U2B in 2016	% expected U2B in NAPLAN 2017
Year 3 Reading	38.1%	40%
Year 5 Reading	34.8%	40%

Kalbar State School will strive to achieve:

- 90% of all students in Prep – Year 6 meet school based Reading benchmarks by the end of the year.
- 40% students in Years 3 and 5 achieving Upper 2 Bands in NAPLAN.
- 50% teaching staff engaged in regular coaching and feedback cycles focusing on the teaching of Reading by the end of the year with 100% engagement at the commencement of 2018.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by:

## This funding will be used to:

- Develop a network of local ECEC to enhance knowledge of on-entry to Prep expectations.
- Provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support or extension to leading to improvement in year level achievement standards including U2B in Reading.
- Continue the development of teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum English through regular Professional Development opportunities.

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- Provide professional development, mentoring and coaching to all teachers developing the understanding of the teaching of reading at Kalbar State School.
- Increase staff capacity in the use of data to inform planning based on the Kalbar State School's Reading Framework.
