Dear Parents and Caregivers,

There has been a confirmed case of Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease at Kalbar State School.

The signs and symptoms, mode of transmission and incubation period are as follows:

Signs and Symptoms: A contagious viral infection that spreads easily among children. It may begin with a rash or blisters around the mouth, hands or feet. The blisters appear as small, white and oval in shape. The rash may appear on outer arms, hands, feet and mouth.

Mode of Transmission: Direct contact with person who has lesions.

Incubation Period: 3 - 5 days

Should your child present any of these symptoms, we recommend that you consult your doctor.
