Under this agreement for 2019
Kalbar State School will receive

\$84 461*

This funding will be used to:

- Employ additional Teacher Aide time in the Prep – Year 3 classrooms focusing on teaching teams.
- Provide additional targeted support in English across Prep – Year 3 before school programs.
- Ensure 80% of students in Years Prep-6 demonstrating C or above in English.
- Invest in Early Years Transitions with local kindy providers to ensure school readiness for pre-prep students and their families.

Our initiatives include:

- Develop strong connections to community kindy programs enhancing knowledge of on-entry to Prep expectations.
- Implement Early Start Data collection in Prep and Year 1.
- Re-invigorate early years literacy and numeracy development through Puggles Play Learning by Kalbar State School for our community aged birth – 4 years old.
- Provide Prep and Year 1 teachers opportunities for collaboration working with Early Years providers in Semester 2.
- Quality assure curriculum and pedagogy practice in English.
- Additional Speech Language Pathologist support for the year (0.2 FTE).
- Build capacity in teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum content descriptions and achievement standards encompassing the termly Kalbar SS Planning and Moderation Cycle.
- Review the school pedagogical framework and embed it as the shared language of teaching and learning in English.
- Build teacher capacity through targeted Professional Learning in English:
 - Assessment processes.
 - Clarity around curriculum intent, establish where individual students are in their learning.
 - Diagnose details of student learning and to monitor learning progress.
 - Build a culture of self-evaluation and reflection of teaching practices.

Our school will improve student outcomes by:

Employ additional Speech Language Pathologist support (0.2) for the year	\$21 000
Release teachers in Prep – Year 1 for Early Years transitions and collaboration – Semester 2	\$7 300
Employ Teacher Aides to support small group differentiated instruction in classrooms from Prep – Year 6	\$55 661
Puggles Play Learning resources	\$500
