Under this agreement for 2020 Kalbar State School

This funding will be used to

- Invest in additional Speech Language Pathologist each week for the year.
- Ensure 85% of students in Prep – Year 6 demonstrate a C or above in English.
- Build school wide data for the achievement of students in A-B English (Semester 1, 2019 36% and Semester 2, 2019 40%) to our school goal of 50% (achieving a B or above in English).
- Invest in Early Years transitions with local kindy providers to ensure school readiness for pre-prep students and their families.

Our initiatives include

- Additional Speech Language Pathologist support for the year focussing on individual speech and language programs for students, as well as building capacity in staff, to deliver these programs and provide in class adjusted teaching strategies catering for individual student needs.
- Employ a Learning Support / WIN (What I need) teacher 2 days a week increasing the Learning Support ratio in the school to support the teaching and learning of English for all learning abilities.
- Quality assure curriculum and pedagogy practices in English.
- Review the school pedagogical framework.
- Build capacity through targeted professional learning in English:
 - Assessment processes
 - Clarity around curriculum intent, establish where individuals are at with their learning.
 - Diagnose details of student learning and to monitor learning progress.
 - Sustain a culture of self-evaluation and reflection of teaching practices.
- Embed the Kalbar State School whole school provision of the Australian Curriculum.
- Collaboratively build capacity in teacher understanding and skills of the Australian Curriculum.
- Implement a PEP (Prep Experience Program) from Term 2 – Term 4 supporting our community in the entry to Prep.
- Continue to develop strong connections to community kindy programs enhancing the knowledge of on-entry to prep expectations to families.

Employ additional Speech Language Pathologist support (0.2FTE) for the year	\$25 000
Release teachers in Prep for Early Years Transitions and collaborations (Semester 2)	\$7 300
Employ additional STLAN (0.4FTE)	\$40 000 (\$37 227.21)
Puggles Play Learning	\$1 000
Additional Teacher Aide support	\$10 000
(PEP) Prep Experience Program set up and resources	\$2 000
